WAYNE AND MAYWOOD SITES - SCHEDULE FOR SUBMITTAL OF CERCLA DOCUMENTS

The purpose of this letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of April 11 in which we discussed the schedule for submittal of a revised Wayne proposed plan and for the Maywood feasibility study and proposed plan. As we discussed, your comments on the Draft Final Wayne proposed plan are currently being incorporated and a revised plan will be mailed to you by April 14. All changes between the March 27 draft and this version will be shaded, so that you can easily identify the differences between the two documents. A draft of the Maywood proposed plan will also be sent to you at this time. The purpose of sending you this copy, in advance of the formal submittal, is to receive your feedback on how the dispute resolution language is incorporated before finalizing the document. I will wait to formally submit the Maywood feasibility study and proposed plan until Tuesday, April 19, to allow you a few days to provide comments on the advance copy.

I believe that providing comments early and allowing us to resubmit drafts during your reviews will ultimately shorten the time it will take to finalize these documents.
