NEW JERSEY SITES - CLEANUP CRITERIA

As we recently discussed, there is currently an ongoing discussion between New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and Energy (NJDEPE) and the Department of Energy (DOE) regarding the cleanup criteria to be utilized for the Maywood and Wayne, New Jersey, sites. Cleanup criteria for these sites was the subject of a dispute between the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and DOE, which was resolved in March of this year. It is my understanding that NJDEPE is not yet in agreement with the levels agreed to by DOE and EPA.

A meeting has been scheduled for June 1, 1994, to allow technical representatives of NJDEPE, DOE, and EPA to discuss this issue. Pending the results of that meeting, I would like to recommend that a follow-up meeting be held among senior management of our respective organizations as part of an effort to reach a resolution that is acceptable to each of us.
