Re: Application Process Concerning Federal Facilities Agreement

As we recently discussed via telephone, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP or Department) is interested in exploring it's options concerning the funding of our oversight activities. During previous conversations, we had discussed that the only way the Department of Energy (DOE) could fund the Department's oversight activities was by entering into a Federal Facilities Agreement. We were, in fact, requested to enter into such an agreement.
