I am in receipt of your March 3, 1995 facsimile correspondence and will answer the questions you posed in the order received.

1) With regard to my comments concerning Dr. Resnikoff's February 20, 1995 memorandum, I have already provided my evaluation as I was the author of the January 17, 1995 response to you concerning the December 12, 1994 "RWMA" document regarding resampling. As you know, this memorandum presented the information in the February 20, 1995 "RWMA" evaluation but in greater detail.

2) In reference to the purpose of the site Risk Assessment, this was described in detail in my February 6, 1995 letter to your attention.

3) Finally and in regard to how both residential and non-residential cleanup criteria meet 1×10^{-6} risk requirement, each scenario is based upon the duration of exposure which has a proportional effect upon health risk. The number of hours one is exposed to a potential effect in a workplace differs from potential exposure periods in a residence, i.e more time is spent at home than at work. Hence, the site specific criteria differ.
