Dear Mr. Redmon:

I would like to thank you for all the time and information you have provided to me regarding this situation in working with the soils.

I understand now that the criteria that the DOE goes by in considering contaminated soils a health hazard is 5.0 PCI/g and higher. Anything under this rate is not considered a danger.

On site the surface along Money Street is 5.0 PCI/g or greater and the soils are contaminated in this area from the surface down. Although other designated area where extensive borings were done is contaminated below 1 foot which the bore loggings would indicate, and the soils that are in the first 1 foot can be removed from site or used elsewhere on site without health hazard nor do these materials have to be trucked to a location designated by DOE.

We appreciate all your assistance regarding this and as we discussed would appreciate if we could get the boring depths plotted on the boring location chart Page 16 Figure 4-1.
