Your request pertained to the following identified FUSRAP sites and materials: St. Louis, MO; Wayne, NJ; Maywood, NJ; and Tonawanda, NY. You requested "copies of records, files, memoranda, studies, reports and correspondence, in whatever media they are stored, that address the following as applicable to each of the above-identified FUSRAP sites:"

Disposal of material on or off site

2. Results of tests for RCRA constituents on site

3. Levels of contamination of RCRA constituents on site

The records in the control and possession of the U.S. Department of Energy Oak Ridge Operations Office which are responsive to the requested information in items 1, 2 and 3 for the Tonawanda site and items 2 and 3 for the St. Louis, Wayne, and Maywood sites are enclosed in their entirety along with an index of the documents. Studies on material disposal options (item 1) are still ongoing for the St. Louis, Wayne, and Maywood sites and are anticipated to be completed within the next 12 to 18 months.
